(Give examples of how you can do this.)

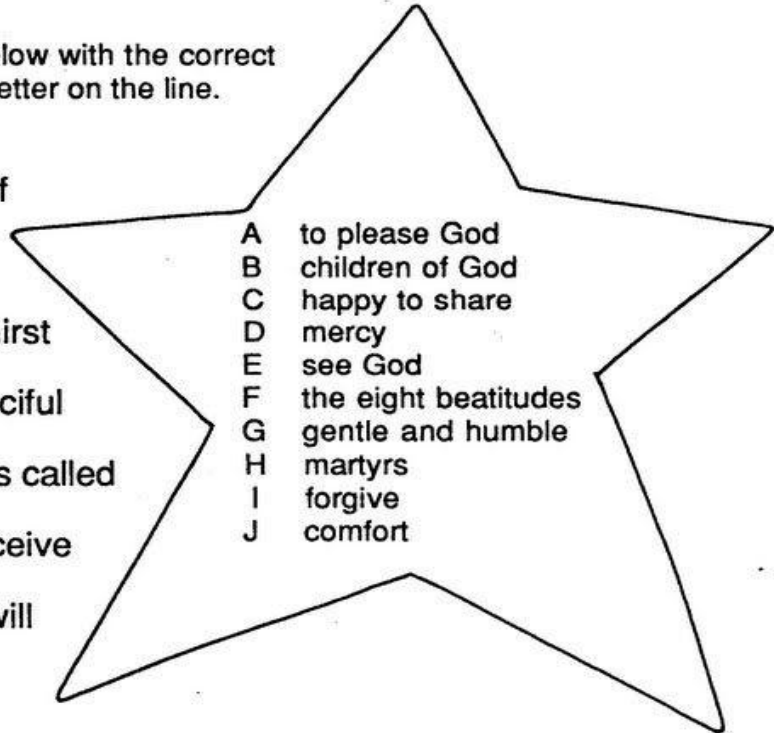
