Lesson: Jesus Is Risen! He is Alive!

Memory Verses of Power (MVP):

Studio 3-K/K: For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. John 3:16

Clubhouse: Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new. 2 Corinthians 5:17

(NKJV)

Scripture summary:

1. After His crucifixion and burial, Jesus arises from the tomb on the third day as He said.
2. Before dawn on the first day of the week, Mary Magdalene and other women go to the tomb to anoint His body with spices they had prepared, but Jesus is not in the tomb. Two angels are in the tomb and tell the women Jesus has risen. Mary and the other women hurry to tell Peter and John.
3. Peter and John go to the tomb. They see that Jesus is not there. They are amazed and confused.
4. Jesus makes Himself known to his disciples proving to them that He is Jesus and is alive.
5. Jesus commissions them to go tell everyone in the world about God's love, repentance, and forgiveness.

Discussion Questions:

1. What do the angels tell the women about Jesus? Mathew 28:5,6
2. What message do the angels want the women to give to the disciples? Matthew 28:7
3. Was Jesus in the tomb when Peter and John arrived? Why not? Matthew 28:5,6
4. How do the disciples recognize Jesus? John 20:27, Luke 23:30, John 21:6,7
(He shows the holes in His hands, breaks bread (eats) and speaks with them as He did before.)
5. What does Jesus commission (to give authority to) His disciples to do? Matthew 28:18,19

Encouragement:

1. Jesus took our sins upon Himself. When we believe this and repent (turn away) from sin, we receive forgiveness from God. We become His children and He becomes our Father. Salvation through Jesus Christ is God's free gift to us because He loves us.
2. Jesus promises to always be with us and to help us make disciples in all the world. Matthew 28:19
Disciple - someone who loves Jesus, follows his teaching, and helps other people follow His teaching.

By His death, His children He did save

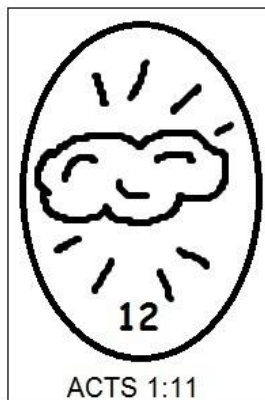
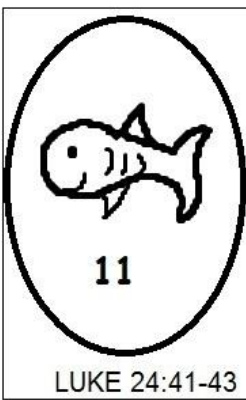
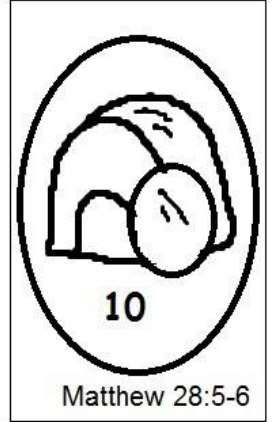
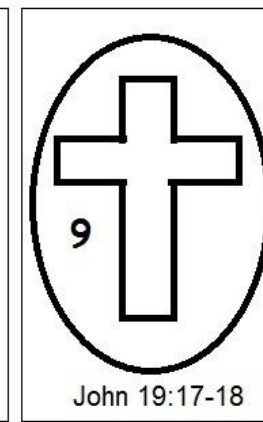
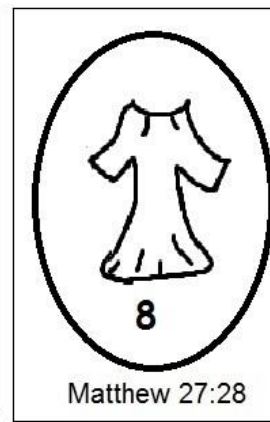
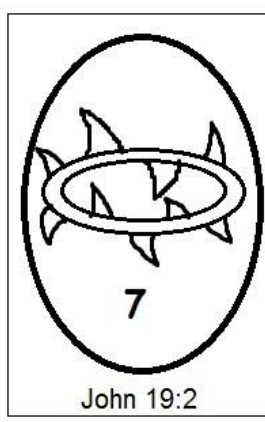
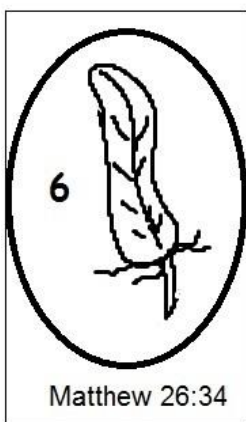
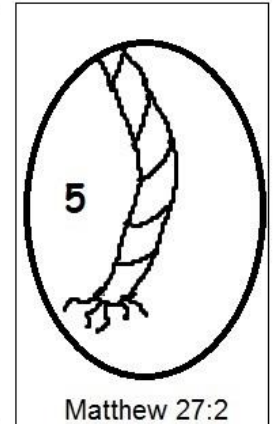
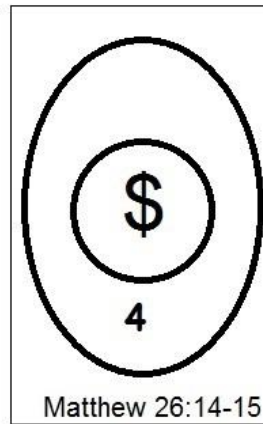
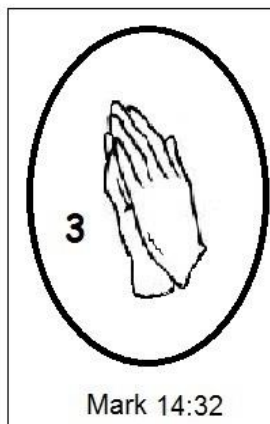
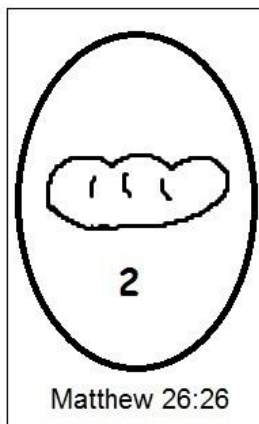
The "M" reminds us of the mercy the Messiah showed

Resurrection Eggs Coloring Page.



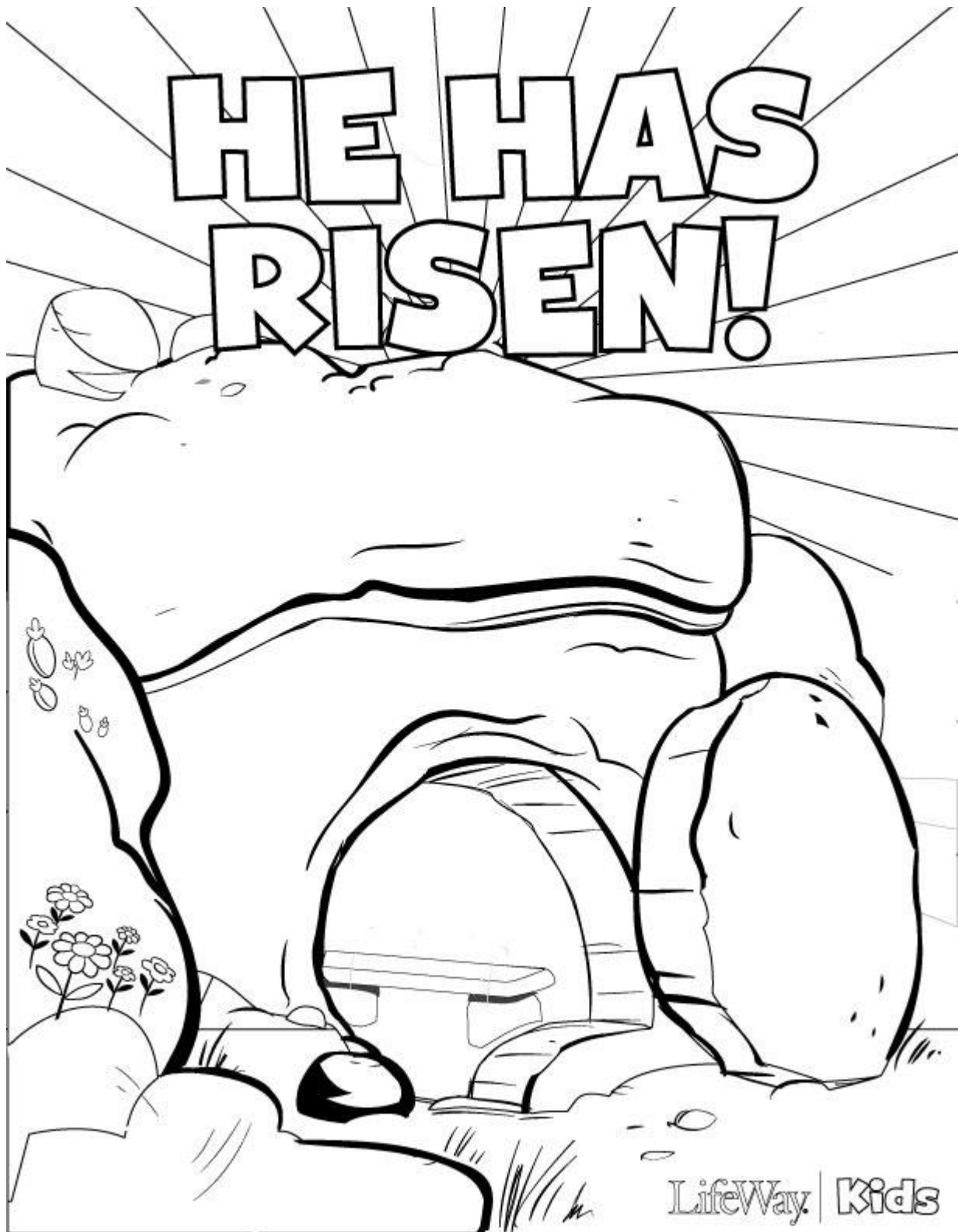
Happy Easter

5. **Rope**- Jesus was bound up and led away by soldiers
6. **Feather**- Peter denied Jesus 3 times & rooster crowed just like Jesus said it would happen
7. **Thorns**- They placed a crown of thorns on Jesus head
8. **Purple Robe**- Jesus robe was taken away from him
9. **Cross**- Jesus died on a cross for our sins
10. **Tomb**- Jesus was placed in a tomb and rose on the third day
11. **Fish**- Jesus ate fish with the disciples
12. **Clouds**- Jesus went up to Heaven
